Partnership meeting in Lodz/PL

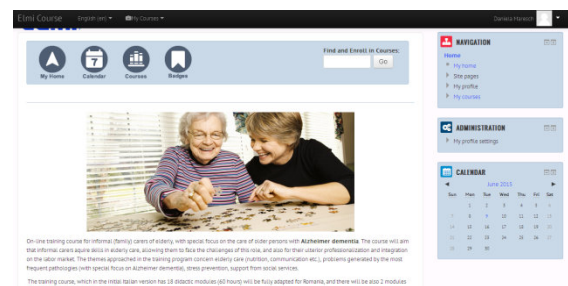
