Last tasks of ELMI

Within this final phase of the ELMI project all activities foreseen by the application have been realized:

- The preparation and the transfer of the ELMI tool from the Italian partner to the Romanian partner
- The realization of the ELMI platform containing the e-learning course: www.elmicourse.ro
- The Handbook for family carers
- The testing of the tool realized on 40 family cares in Romania
- The elaboration of the 2 modules for each country in Poland and Czech Republic and the testing realized in these countries
- The transferability reports
- The last dissemination workshops in Romania, Poland and Czech Republic organized
- The ECVET round tables organized in Romania, Poland and Czech Republic
- The elaboration of the concept paper – Strategy for re-insertion of family carers on the labour market

Final meeting in Bucharest

After 24 months of hard work the ELMI partnership composed of partners coming from five countries (IT, RO, AT, CZ and PL) organized the last partnership meeting in Bucharest on 10th February 2016. During this meeting the very final steps to be taken were established and plans of exploitation were made.



International conference

One of the most important dissemination activities within the ELMI project was the organization of an international conference in Bucharest on 10th February 2016. This big event was perfectly organized by the Romanian coordinator “Habilitas” and hosted more than 70 participants.

The major topic was the presentation of the results and outcomes that the ELMI project realized during these last two years.



The handbook as well as the e-learning training course for informal caregivers were shown to the audience and the different partners involved in the piloting of the ELMI online course presented the results and experiences made within the testing phase in their respective countries (*Romania, Czech Republic, Poland*).

One important point of the conference was the information coming from informal carers about the experiences made in Romania accompanied by the presentation of video-interviews with informal carers.
