THE ELMI PROJECT

AIMS TO MAKE INFORMAL CARE A VALUABLE RESOURCE ON THE LABOUR MARKET ...

Romania, Poland and Czech Republic are three countries where the care for elderly people lies mostly on the own family. For these countries the ELMI project follows two aims:

- The transfer of an e-learning training course for informal caregivers from Italy to **Romania**
- The analysis of its potential transfer to **Czech Republic and Poland**



Furthermore - in order to support a qualified mobility of Romanian workers to Italy - the training acquired by Romanian carers within the ELMI project will be recognized in Italy in the framework of an ECVET Memorandum of Understanding.

OUTCOMES

THE MAIN RESULTS OF THE ELMI PROJECT WILL BE...

- an e-learning course transferred from Italy specifically targeting family carers of older persons in Romania aiming at the acquisition of skills and competences useful to provide better care but also to help carers to integrate the labor market
- an online platform of resources for Romanian informal carers
- a handbook for Romanian informal carers
- a concept-paper for a strategy of integration on the labor market of former informal carers
